Thank you for sending your child to Awana tonight! We hope they had a good time and will want to return next week!

Our clubs meet beginning in September until April on Tuesday evenings from 7:00 pm to 9:00pm. At Awana we play games, sing songs, have Bible lessons, and work in individual handbooks each week. The clubbers earn awards to place on their uniform throughout the year. The clubs are as follows:

Cubbies (Preschool)

Cubbies is for children who are **fully potty-trained** and 3 or 4 years old. The children learn Bible lessons, play games, sing songs, make crafts and have a small snack each week. Cubbies each receive a colourful handbook full of weekly lessons called “Bear Hugs”. Parents are encouraged to read each week’s Bear Hug to their child and follow the simple instructions to complete it. During club night, leaders will go over each week’s Bear Hug and the Cubbie will have an opportunity to recite the Bible verse they learned at home. As they progress through the book they will earn patches to wear on their Cubbie vest. **We have limited space for Cubbies, therefore priority will be given to returning clubbers, children of FBC members and siblings of clubbers registered last year.**

Sparks (Kindergarten – Grade 2)

Sparks is for children who are 5 to 7 years old. Each club night the Sparks work in their individual handbooks, participate in a spirited game time, and enjoy singing and listening to a Bible lesson. The Sparks “fly” through three handbooks with Sparky the firefly. Over the three years Sparkies will survey the main characters of the Bible and see how the whole Bible fits together as God’s plan to save the world through Jesus Christ. As Bible verses are memorized and sections completed the Sparks will earn Jewels. These jewels go on their Pilot Wings which they wear on their Sparks vest. Awards are presented to clubbers at the end of council time each week.

Truth and Training (Grades 3 – 6)

“T&T” is for kids ages 8 to 11 years old. Following the flag ceremony, the T&T have their game time then handbook time. During handbook time, Grades 3 and 4 go on an “Ultimate Adventure” through two handbooks and earn dog bones to wear on their club badge. Grades 5 and 6 are on an “Ultimate Challenge” through two handbooks and earn patches to place on their uniforms. Each book answers eight questions about the Bible, God and the Lord Jesus Christ and how to follow God’s instructions for life. Clubbers complete discoveries in their handbooks and earn awards. T&T joins Sparks for council time where they sing songs and listen to a Bible lesson. Awards are presented to the clubbers at the end of council time each week.

Trek (Grades 7 – 8)

In Trek, Jr. High students “travel” through a handbook that deals with subject matter specifically relevant to this key time in their lives. Each week they have a discussion and lesson time led by their Trek leader, game time and handbook time. Trek also serves in the Awana club by helping out at game time and doing other jobs on club night.

Journey (Grades 9 – 12)

Our Journey clubbers learn to serve by helping out on Awana night with game time and other jobs. They also have their own handbook time, game time and lesson discussion time with their Journey leader. With four Main Studies and several Electives to choose from the Journey clubbers work on memorization, Bible study, serving and personal applications for growth.

How do you start?

If this is your first time at Awana or you are entering a new club you will receive an Entrance Booklet specific to each club. When you have completed the sections in your entrance booklet you will receive your club uniform and handbook. **It is important that you work on the section(s) before coming to club so that you are ready for club night.** Whether you join Awana or not, the entrance booklet is yours to keep. These booklets contain important information about your relationship to God and His son, Jesus Christ. If you have any questions regarding this information talk to your parents, the family that brought you to Awana or contact our club.

Registration

Once you finish your entrance book you can only receive your uniform and handbook if you have registered, so please complete the enclosed registration form and return it along with the fees to the Awana secretary on club night. **Our registration fee is \$45 per clubber to a maximum of \$120 per family.** These fees cover the cost of your uniform, handbook and awards. Please make cheques payable to Fairhaven Bible Chapel. ***If this amount poses a financial hardship, please come and see us,*** we want your child to have the opportunity to grow in spiritual wisdom and understanding and we will find a way for this to happen. The fees that we charge do not cover the full cost of the program. If you wish to donate above what is paid in fees, a tax deductible receipt can be issued if requested.

Dues

We ask clubbers to bring 25 cents in dues each week. These are used to offset the cost of incentive awards. If you wish, these dues may be paid for an entire month or for the whole year at once. However, if you cannot bring dues or forget, we still want you to come and have a good time.

Theme Nights

Occasionally we have fun theme nights and we invite you to join in the fun. For example, we may have a hat night and you can wear your favourite or craziest hat to club that night.

Parents

Please feel free to come anytime and observe clubs in session. However, if you cannot stay, it is important that you are not late picking up your child at when your children are dismissed. You are welcome to come back early and watch your clubber receive their awards at the end of council time.

Donations

Our club welcomes financial support from anyone interested in partnering with us in ministering to our clubbers. All donations will receive a tax deductible receipt.
